

On application of P. S. Wilson and Newton Robertson
Directors of School District - No 8 and P. D. Davis on his own behalf
I made the following survey

After duly qualifying on oath, George Stubblefield and Thos
Brierly as chainmen I proceeded as follows

By placing a 2x4 pine post 3 feet long 18 inches in the ground
resting on broken glass bottles buried 18 inches deep and marked A
at a point on section line between sections 1 and 12 Township 9 South
R 27 East. 7 chains and 30 links west of section corner for sections 1 and 12
on Range line between Ranges 27 and 28 East in Township 9 South
Magnetic bar 20° 30' East and running thence on true course
West 210 feet thence South 210 feet thence East 210 feet thence
North 210 feet to place of Beginning all corners indicated by 2x4
pine posts 3 feet long and resting on broken glass bottles 18 inches deep
all situated in NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 12 Township 9 South
Range 27 East and containing one acre more or less or more par-
ticularly 4900 square yards
