

Survey of building lot in Monument sold by P. S. Wilson and Wife to Henry Humphrey and others

After duly qualifying on oath George Stubblefield and Thos Brierly as Chainbearers

I commenced at charred post 6 inches in diameter two feet in the ground and even with the surface 30 feet west from centre of Section No 1 in T^p 9 South of Range 27 East which point is indicated by a stone 8 x 9 x 14 marked $\frac{76}{28}$ and Thence West (on 22° East)

288 feet to stone marked A and + on top resting on broken glass bottles buried one foot deep Thence South

150 feet to stone marked A and + on top resting on broken glass bottles 18 inches deep

Thence East-

288 feet to stone marked A $\frac{150}{28}$ resting on broken glass bottles buried 18 inches deep

Thence North

150 feet to place of beginning and containing 4800 square yards. all situated in N E $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1 T^p 9 S. R 27 East-
