TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I herewith protest the survey made by John E. Shaw, then Grant County Surveyor, at the request of Earl H. Brent and W. B. Prophet on June 5, 1959, asking for a re-establishment of the north quarter corner of Section 35, Twp. 13 S., R. 31 E., W.M., and made according to filed report commencing August 17, 1959, purporting to re-locate the quarter corner common to Sections 26 and 35, Twp. 13 S., R. 31 E., W.M.

I also protest the survey made by John E. Shaw, then Grant County Surveyor, at the request of Earl H. Brent to re-establish the west and north lines of the  $E\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, Twp. 13 S., R. 31 E., W.M., which survey was commenced August 10, 1959.

The reason for this pretest is that the corners, as re-located, do not fit any former property ties and if allowed to stand would throw a cloud on the title to all adjacent property.
