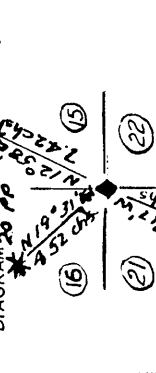

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

(Reference FSH 5681.65)

History of original corner establishment:

Original contract survey for G.L.O made in August, 1874

Original corner was a marked stone 15 x 14 x 8, with 3 notches on the east side,
and 3 notches on the south side.

No bearing trees or other accessories

Description of corner evidence found:

Corner stone above described found.

Marked rock was actually closer to 17 x 15 x 7 in measurements

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the
original location of this corner. Monument set consists of a 2" brass disk welded to a 2" galvan-
ized iron pipe with an 8" square piece of flat iron welded to its base, approximately
30" in length, buried approximately 20" in the ground with a mound or rock surrounding
it. Disk is stamped with metal dies as follows:

From this corner: a 10" ponderosa pine tree scribed
T19S, R26E, S15, ET bears N. 42° 15' E. a distance of
7.12 chains:

A 14" ponderosa pine tree scribed T19S, R26E, S21, ET
bears S. 69° 17' W. a distance of 2.82 chains

A 20" ponderosa pine tree scribed T19S, R26E, S16, ET, bears N. 1° 31' W. a distance
of 1.32 chains
