The ordinary language of ~~Land~~ owners of these sections agree that the original location of the Corner was near a certain Old Granary belonging to Patsey Daly. Mr Daly also produced a deed from Geo Knisley to Sam Carpenter dated May 12 1888. Recorded May 4 1888 Page 272 Book # of a tract of land 8 rods square laid out 8 rods North 8 rods East 8 rods South and 8 rods West to point of beginning which was the North West Cor Sec 22

Mr Daly produced another deed from P L Hess & Malissa Hess dated May 23 1895. Recorded Vol 11 page 234 to Mary A Daly of a tract of Land having for its South Corner, or its initial Corner. The North East Corner of the 1st tract of Land described. Mr Patsey Daly testified that he was present and helped lay out the 2nd tract. Stating the North E Cor of the 1st tract was there at that time (ie May 23 1895). This Corner is also missing but the North East Corner of the 2nd tract was placed at the corner of the fence which enclosed the tract. This fence is still in use. Mr Daly having been sworn and having pointed out the exact location of the NE Cor of the tract ^{dated} recorded May 23 1895 from P L Hess & Malissa Hess to Mary Daly. I ran S W from this Old Fence Corner (ie the NE Cor of said tract) along the fence as called for in the deed 20 rods and 4 ft.

(Finding a marked Rock on Line which Mr Daly says was marked with a hatchet as a line mark) Thence South from ^(the south Cor or initial point of survey of 2nd tract, as established and called for by the Corner one distance from NE Cor according to Old deed.) 8 rods as called for in The Knisley Deed Thence West 8 rods and set the Permanent Corner of Sections 21, 22, 15, 16 from the Borneas and Corners of these Old Deeds. Corroborated by the Measurements East and West 319 ch (The proportion of falling subtracted) And North & South 120^{ch} 80^{lks}, See data of witnesses
