After Establishing the North and South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corners of Sec 22 by the SW Cor. Sec 27 Draw a straight line from opposite  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corners across the Sec 22 and 27 setting fence  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. every 20 Ch. at the intersection of these lines after correcting them to True Line and set the fence  $\frac{1}{4}$  on True Line and halfway from True Centre to the Corresponding  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corners I placed the Centres of Sec 22 and 27 and established them permanently also the  $\frac{1}{16}$  Corners that were called for in the application

North  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  CS 16x6x7 set-deep 2 inches above ground in a mound of Rocks

North W Cor. A Rock 14x6x7 tapering Marked 11 on each Edge and CS Set in Gully E of road near SW corner about 16 feet from fence, an Old Cranberry (in NE corner) bears S 75° W 31 lbs. A ledge to the S. A ledge of Rocks one point (NW of 88) Marked a Solid Rock of this Ledge CS which bears from the SW in Sec 22. North 54° E 354 lbs

South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Cor. Sec 22 A Rock 12x8x4 set-deep in Ground in Stubble field. The East-Terminus of Division line of the Estate which is 16 ch S W from the Bridge Bears S 51.30 E 342 lbs

Centre of 22 A Boulder 12x9x6 Marked +CS at foot of Little clump Alpine (Doubtly) 18' Dia 36' Dia bears due W 142 lbs

" " 9 A Marked Rock planted right at Corner of hanging wire fence which runs North, and then runs East

" " 10 Boulder buried deep from which a Cottonwood <sup>12'</sup> bears North to 31 East 130 lbs

" " 11 Rock set in stubble field on true line from opposite  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner on E  $\frac{1}{4}$  side of the sec

" " 12 Boulder close to West Bank, in mound of Rocks G.C. Stumpless Bear S 35° 45' W 34 lbs

" " 13, 14 not-called for

" " 15 This point was determined accurately to determine the centre of NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 27 but was not-set as all the land on north side of River belongs to J. Deardorff and this corner did not affect him

" " 16 A Rock 12x6x8 with mound of rocks. 28 lbs S of centre of County road in excavation

Located of Corners of Sec 27. The North East Corner is buried. Alpine bear <sup>21 lbs</sup> S 20° 45' E, 12.43 lbs

Alpine bear <sup>18 lbs</sup> S 14° E, 11.49 lbs

" " 4 Rock 12x12x4 set-deep projecting a little above ground in timothy meadow

" " 5 Rock 9x8x7 in mound of rocks

" " 6 A Rock 12x7x6 Boulder on East side of fence about 40 lbs in timothy meadow. A Y 24' Dia Bear N 66° E 990 lbs

" " 7 Determined but not-established no call under circumstances

" " 8 Rock 4x9x7 in mound of rocks

" " 9 Rock 12x10x8 set-in ground mound of rocks

" " 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 not-called for in Application
