the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor Sec 10 fall S 32° lbs

Then from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor Sec 10 Ran North set temporary corners each 20 ch
the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor Sec 10 fall W 15 lbs: and at the correct intersection of these lines placed Centre
of Sec 10

Then corrected and established the $\frac{1}{4}$ corners and centre of Section thus

Centre of Sec 10 a Rock $14 \times 14 \times 16$ in a mound of rocks
A Solid Rock Bears N 50° W 16 lbs. marked + on E face

$\frac{1}{6}$ Cor E of centre Sec 10 Rock in mound of Rocks
a pine 30' dia bears S $72^{\circ} 55'$ W 247 lbs
Solid Red rock marked + Bears W $45^{\circ} 45'$ W 60 lbs

$\frac{1}{6}$ Cor W of centre Sec 10 a rock set deep with pits E & W

$\frac{1}{4}$ E of SW Cor Sec 10 a rock $10 \times 8 \times 8$ set in ground with pits
County road East 300 lbs
Old Road grass grown visible W 100 lbs

$\frac{1}{4}$ Cor W of SE Cor Sec 10 A rock in a mound of rocks
A pine 14' dia N $28^{\circ} 30'$ E 212 lbs
A pine 18' dia S 61° E 297 lbs

I then crossed lines from opposite $\frac{1}{4}$ corners of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 Thus
begin at E $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor x SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 Ran W across SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 falling 8 lbs South
begin at S $\frac{1}{4}$ " x SE $\frac{1}{4}$ " " Ran E across SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 fall 6 East
Corrected these lines and at their intersection set centre of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 a Rock $10 \times 16 \times 8$ Marked $\frac{1}{16}$ +
From which a pine 12' dia Bears S $63^{\circ} 35'$ E 40 lbs
" " " " 12' dia " S $16^{\circ} 40'$ W 58 lbs
" " " " 8' dia " N 29° W 16 lbs

I then crossed the lines of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 in like manner
and at their intersection set centre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 10 a Rock $12 \times 12 \times 6$ Marked $\frac{1}{16}$ + with pits
Red rock extending 6' above ground marked + bears S 46° W 26 lbs
" " " " 6-10 " " " + " 26 $30^{\circ} 10'$ E
