was present at Original Survey. Caspary Surveyor
Began at SE Corner of Town 185 R. 26 E. Thence North 40 ch
and established the [unclear] at this place. Then
returned to SE Cor Sec 1 T. 185 R. 26 E. Then West 20 ch Thence
North 40 ch & Established the [unclear] of Dayville as shown
on plat in County Clerk's Office, [unclear] as Flagman

Am certain that this Corner is the SE Cor of Dayville is in its
original position except that it has been [unclear] by a wagon
Made a piece of fence along the North line with [unclear] the Ruts
Do not know of any ^{other original town corner} except the NW Cor lot [unclear] [unclear]
Mr. Glovers property. The old stake [unclear] and fence post set in it; also
the West line of Franklins are [unclear] moved back by Myself & Franklins
