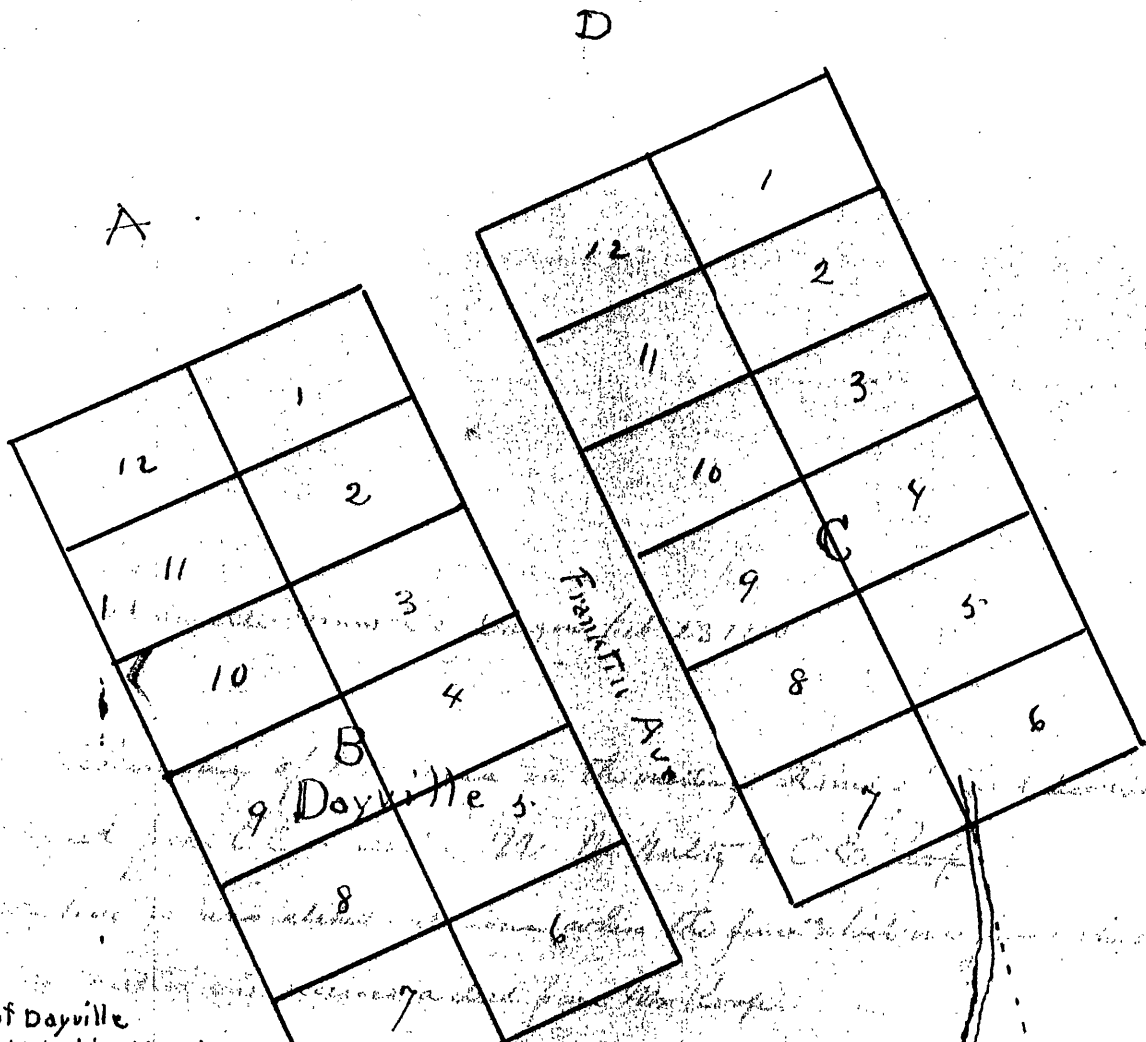




Read deed read

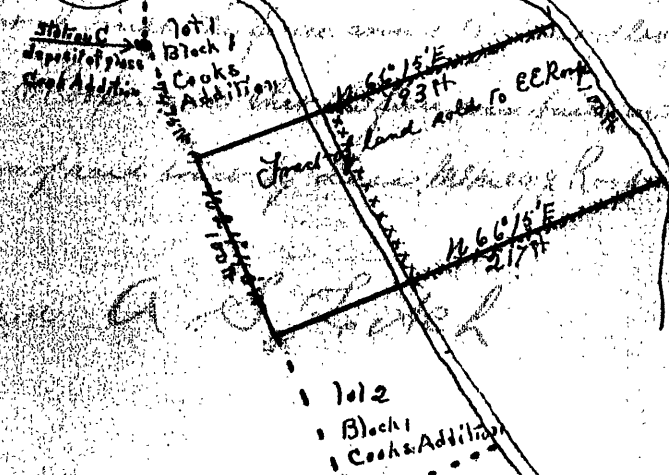
And that testified to having built the fence below
