

To establish certain Corners in Sec 30

There were but two parties interested Namely Mr G E Jones and Morris Mack

Mr Mack was notified and appeared on April 26th 1911

We began at NE corner Sec 36 T8S R29E from South 40.16 to E 1/4 cor Sec 36 fall E 55.16 making the course
S 0° 51' W 40.16 ch

Then from E 1/4 cor Ran South 0° 51' W 20 ch set temp 1/4 cor, continued same course

and at 39.86 ch found the SE cor Sec 30 without falling

Then from SE cor ran West 46.36 chains found the S 1/4 cor Sec 30 falling S 45.16 ch

Making the Course N 89° 21' W 40.30 ch

From S 1/4 cor ran N 89° 21' W 20 chains set and established the NW cor which falls here (ie the SW corner of Lot 24 Sec 30)

From SW cor Lot 24 Sec 30 T8S R29E Ran N 0° 45' E 19.78 chains and established the NW cor Lot 24 in the Bed of Ravine

which is a Rock 8x6 ft also marked a solid Bed Rock (witness) chisled W and set the corner on top of the mark W

Then proceeded to the NE cor of SE 1/4 x SE 1/4, connected it to proper place and set it permanently

Then from SE cor Sec 30 Ran E 20 ch set temp 1/4 cor, continued and at 40.52 ch found the S 1/4 cor Sec 29 T8R 29
falling S 59.16 ch

Then return to temp SW cor of SE 1/4 x SW 1/4 Sec 29 set it on line & established permanently

Thence Ran N 0° 45' E 19.74 ch & established NE cor x SW 1/4 x SW 1/4 Sec 29
