A P Snyder Appeared

To determine the Corners between Snow and Snyder and McRae
Land belonging to each shown on plat also the corners established

Red tint shows Snows

Blue tint shows Snyders and Orange crosses show corners established

Green " " McRaes

I found the NE cor - the NW cor - the West 1/4 cor missing

also the NW cor x NE 1/4 x SE 1/4 Sec 1 has been established By Caspary (See Official Plat of Dayville)

// There fore measured from NW cor Sec 1 T13 S R26 E to NW cor Sec 6 T13 R27 E

Measured by triangulation on account of John Days River find the distance to be 123.06 ch

which makes proportional distance due to each 1/2 mile or quarter section 41.02 ch

From NW cor Sec 6 T13 R27 E I measured N89.30' W 41.02 ch and set temp NE cor

Sec 1 and at 41.02 beyond this temp cor I set temp NW cor Sec 1 T13 R26

// Then measured by triangulation from SE cor Sec 1 T13 S R26 E to the E 1/4 cor Sec 36 T12 S R26 E and find

the distance to be 119.36 ch making proportion 1/4 section distance 39.78 ch

on this basis I connected with the Temp NE cor Sec 1 ^{deep} previously set and established the

NE cor Sec 1 T13 S R26 E same being a Boulder set deep and marked with 6 nails

on four different sides // Then proceed to Temp NW cor Sec 1 and connected and established

by setting a Boulder deep and marked 1/4 cor.

// measured from NW cor to SW cor Sec 1 T13 R26 finding the distance to be 81.06 chains

and true course S 0° 32' E I set and established all the 40 Acre ^{tract} corners along this line

setting marked Rocks // Then ran S 88° 50' E from the West 1/4 corner to the Caspary Corner

and find the distance to be 61.60 ch making proportional distance to each 40 Acre tract = 20.53 ch and

the falling being S 22 links makes true course S 89° 09' E

// set and established the Centre of Sec 1 on this Basis

Survey began June 6 1911 and continued until July 1st 1911 in order to Notify McRae
