 Survey began Sep 14 1911 at NW corner Sec 1 T9 R28 Here appearing A Peabody, Earl Mulkey, Frank Fields personally
 Mr and Mrs Barr waiving Notice rights
 Began at NW cor Sec 1 T9 R28E Ran South on random

79, 91 chs to the S W cor Sec 1 setting temporary corners every 20 chs (the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner being midway) fall E 5 ft of S W cor
 returned and corrected temp corners to correct position Marked Rocks plainly $\frac{1}{16}$ CS and the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor marked $\frac{1}{4}$ CS at each corner set in
 & then began at the $\frac{1}{16}$ corner between NE cor and $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec 1 ran Son Random

80, 49 chs to intersection of S line of Section at a point half way between S E cor and $\frac{3}{4}$ cor Sec 1 fall West $\frac{1}{2}$ ft
 returned and corrected established and marked the temporary corners and placed a mound of Rocks around

Now from the Centre of $\frac{SE}{4}$ Sec 1 Ran West 6'

60 chs to the $\frac{1}{16}$ corner between S W cor and $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec 1 T9 R28E fall N 11 ft
 returned and corrected the temporary $\frac{1}{16}$ corner marked and set permanently in mound of Rocks

Then proceeded to $\frac{1}{4}$ cor Sec 2 Ran S 19.90 chs and set $\frac{1}{16}$ corner permanently in mound of rocks marked $\frac{1}{16}$ CS
 Then proceeded to $\frac{1}{16}$ cor between NW cor and N $\frac{1}{4}$ cor Sec 1 ran S 19.90 ch and set permanent $\frac{1}{16}$ corner rock marked $\frac{1}{16}$ CS in rock mound
