40.00 chains (Set temp $\frac{1}{4}$ at 20 ch) the E $\frac{1}{4}$ cor Sec 7 fall East 18 ft
 Thence from E $\frac{1}{4}$ cor Sec 7 Ran West $0^{\circ}45'N$ to opposite side of section found $\frac{1}{4}$ corner missing
 South

40 the SW cor Sec 7 missing Continued South

39.64 " find the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec 18 fall S 11 ft
 returned to temp SW cor of sec 7 connected marked and set in a mound of Rock 2 "

77.33 ch From SW cor Sec 7 thus established Ran S $89^{\circ}15'E$
 to the SE cor Sec 7 fall N 17 ft 1 set temp corner in 20 ch
 I returned and connected temporary corner found the S $\frac{1}{4}$ cor was missing I therefore established it
 as shown in sketch. Distance from S $\frac{1}{4}$ cor to SE cor 180 ch in mound of rocks marked $\frac{1}{4}$ CS corner.
