Resurvey of portions of sections 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, and 22, T 9 S, R 28 E, W.M. Claimants, L. Sweek, Marion Gray, Harry Bowerman, Jesse Jones and Frank McHaley Oct. 11, 1917.

Commencing at corner common to secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, and re-traced section line south between secs. 9 and 10, using same meridian as for secs. 3, 4 and 5.

40.00 Original 1/4 corner is 38 feet to the west.

80.00 Original corner common to secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16 is 75 feet to the west. Corrected meridian 50' to correspond to this line

Thence continue south on new meridian on section line.

20.00 Established a 1/16 corner, a basalt rock 11 x 6 x 4, properly marked, which is the NW corner of Harry Bowermans land. L. Sweek claimant for sec. 16.

40.00 Original 1/4 corner missing, reestablished one to conform with Original field notes (1/4 S - CS)

80.00 Original corner common to secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22 missing. Re-established one. a Basalt rock 14 x 8 x 6, properly marked.

Continue on this section line due south.

20.00 Established a 1/16 corner, a basalt rock 9 x 8 x 5 properly marked

40.00 Original 1/4 corner missing. Reestablished with a basalt rock 12 x 9 x 6 properly marked and set in bed of rock.

60.00 Established a 1/16 corner, a basalt rock 8 x 8 x 5 properly marked, and set in bed of stone.

Oct. 12, 1917.

Thence due east on 40 line through center of SW/4 sec. 22.

20.00 Established a 1/16 corner for center of SW/4 sec. 22, a basalt rock, 13 x 10 x 5, properly marked.

40.00 Established a 1/16 corner common for SW/4 and SE/4 sec. 22, a basalt rock 8 x 8 x 7 properly marked and set in mound of rock.

Thence due south

20.00 Original 1/4 corner common to secs. 22 and 27 bear S 25° 0.15 chains. Thence returned with instrument to the 1/16 corner common to SW/4 and SE/4 sec. 22.

Thence due north through center of sec. 22.

20.00 Est. a 1/16 corner in center of sec. 22, a basalt rock, 10 x 8 x 6, properly marked and bedded in rock.

40.00 Est. a 1/16 corner common to NW/4 and NE/4 sec. 22, a basalt rock 12 x 10 x 4, properly marked and bedded in rock.

Thence due west on 40 line

20.00 Est. a 1/16 corner for center of NW/4 sec. 22, a basalt rock 14 x 7 x 5 properly marked and bedded in rock.

40.00 1/16 corner on the west center line of NW/4 sec. 22 bears S 20° E 0.18 chans. Claimants for above, Harry Bowerman, Marion Gray and Frank McHaley.

October 13, 1917.

Thence carried transit to a point on sec. line between secs. 21 and 22, 10.00 chains south of 1/4 corner common to secs. 21 and 22, and took observations on corner common to secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, which is N 58° 15' W. Set a flag on this point for a back sight.

Thence carried transit to above most mentioned corner, set transit over this corner, and obtained meridian by a back sight on the point 10.00 chains south of 1/4 corner common to secs. 21 and 22.

59.60 Thence due south on sec. line
Mound of rock corresponding to description of original 1/4 corner common for sec. 20 and 21, but with marks obliterated. Remarkd it 1/4 S - CS
