1330.5 to old S.W. corner of ne ne of section 30 which I mark
with a basalt rock 12x12x8 in the ground marked 1/16
C.S. thence,

North

1320.0 to N.W. corner of ne ne of section 30, set granite rock
14x8x12 in the ground chiseled 1/16 C.S. whence an
apple tree 12 ins. in diameter bears N. 30 E. - 50 ft.

thence,

East.

1330.5 To N.E. corner of section 30-13-32 set basalt rock
12x8x10 in. in ground. chiseled with five notches on east
and two on south side. C.S.

Note:-the location of this latter corner checks the
position of the original and subsequent surveys as
described by old residents Eg. Dan Fisk and C.C. Oliver.
