

Survey of School House Site - District
No 8 Grant Co Oregon

On application of P. S. Dillon and Newton
Robinson Directors on behalf of School District
and O. L. Harris on his own behalf
I made the following survey. After
qualifying on oath George Stubblefield
and Thos Brewerly as Chammers I
proceeded as follows

By placing a 2x4 pine post - 3 feet
long 18 inches in the ground resting on
broken glass bottles and marked A. on
section line between Secs 15/12 T9 S R 27 E
7.32 chains East on true course (the magnetic
course being $20^{\circ}30'$ East) from cor. of Secs 15/12
on Range line East of Township 9 S. R. 27 E
and running thence on T. C. on $20^{\circ}30'$ E. West
240 feet to 2x4 pine post - resting on broken
glass bottles 18 in deep thence S. F. C. 240 feet
to 2x4 pine post - resting on broken glass 18 in deep
thence East T. C. 240 feet to 2x4 pine post - rest-
ing on broken glass bottles 18 in deep thence N
on T. C. 240 feet to place of beginning all
situate in SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 Sec 12 Township 9
South R 27 East - and containing 4900 square
yards
