Wilson and wife I made the following survey calling to my assistance as Chairman George Stubbfield and Thos Buerly and after qualifying on oath commenced as follows by placing charred post 6 in in diameter and 2 feet down even with surface of the ground thirty feet west of stone 8 in x 9 in x 14 marked to be the center of sec 20 1 Township 9 South Range 2 East and Commence West S 22° East 288 feet to stone marked A and + on top and resting on broken glass buried 18 in deep thence South 150 feet to stone marked A and + on top resting on broken glass 18 in deep thence East ^{288 ft} to stone marked A ¹⁵⁰/_{CS} resting on broken glass buried 18 in deep thence N 150 feet to place of Beginning and containing 4800 square yards all situated in N E 1/4 of S. W 1/4 Sec 1 Township 9 S R 27 East - E. M.
