

Field Notes of Survey No 5

14-29

Made on application of John George to establish corners of his Homestead claim in Township 14 South Range 29 East Willamette Meridian and to establish corners on line bet- secs 1 & 2

After duly qualifying on oath Henry Hopkins and Thomas Davies as chainbearers. I proceeded to make the following survey.

Commencing at the N.E. cor of Township 14 South Range 29 East and running West on North body of sec 1 bar 21° E

40.00 find no corner as indicated in field notes of U.S. Survey

80.00 find stone mound as indicated in notes. cor destroyed. I find the distance to Mclellan Creek from mound to be 1.80 chains as indicated in notes. I then ran west on North Body of sec 2 bar 21° East-

89.00 find cor to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3 as indicated in notes of U.S. Survey. I then established cor of secs 1<sup>st</sup> and 2 which is a stone 8 x 6 x 12 ins. cut 1 notch on East face 5 notches on W face and C.S. on South side mound of stone built around.

Done in presence of Henry Hopkins & Thos Davies May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1895

56.30 I then ran South bar 21° E on sec line bet- 1 & 2 and find no corner as indicated in field notes U.S. Survey. I then placed temp sec cor. and ran East on sec line bet- 1 and 12.

79.90 find corner in good condition as indicated in notes I then established sec cor to secs 1, 2, 11 and 12 which is a basalt stone 10 x 12 x 21.6 ins in ground in mound of stone done in presence of Henry Hopkins and Thos Davies May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1895
