Commenced at corner to Sections 28, 29, 32 and 33 and after qualifying on oath Clement Glasgow and D. B. Star as chainbearers. Run North on Section line bar 19° E 40° chains to 1/4 sec cor on line between secs 28 and 29. Thence West 15° chains to S E corner of A & Star & Co's Claim Thence North 20 chains to pitch pine stake No 1 from which a forked yellow pine 36 in dia bears S 25° W 25 links distant - thence West 15° chs Thence North 10° chs Thence West 20° chs. Thence South 10° chains Thence East 5° chains Thence South 20° chains Thence East 30 chs to S E corner of claim being place of beginning and initial point of said claim survey and containing 8 acres.
