in T^p 10 South Range 35 East

Commenced at corner to Sections 28, 29,
32 and 33 and after qualifying on oath Clement
Glasgow and J. B. Star as chainbearers.
Run North on Section line for 19° E 40° chains
to 1/4 sec cor on line between secs 28 and 29. Thence
West 15° chains to S E corner of A & Star & Co.
Claim Thence North 20 chains to pitch pine
stake No 1 from which a forked yellow pine
36 in dia bears S 25° W 25 links distant—
thence West 15° chs Thence North 10° chs Thence N 20°
20° chs. Thence South 10° chains Thence East 5° chains
Thence South 20° chains Thence East 30 chs to
S E corner of claim being place of beginning and
initial point of said claim survey and
containing 8 acres.
