placed stone 8 x 12 x 14 and buried charcoal 1 foot deep. From which yellow pine 30 in dia bears N 60° W 37 links dist and Tamarack 18 in dia bears I on line 61 links dist -

This survey established all the corners of H. Caldwells Mining Claim, being SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 sec 31 and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 or SW 1/4 of section 32, Township 10 South Range 35 East - Willamette Mountain Oregon containing 15 acres
