

Survey No 25

Made on application of J. D. Powell to establish corners of tract of land in S W 1/4 of sec 20 described in deed to John Hamburger given by John C. du and wife and recorded on page 183 Book F Records of De Grant County. and to establish corners of Undivided S W 1/4 section 20, T. 13. S. R. 31 East - G. 111

After qualifying on oath Benton E. Eagle and Sam Morgan as Chainmen

I commenced at 1/4 sec cor on section line between sections 20 and 29 and run North on Random line bearing 21° E found by back-sight - on cor sees 20, 21, 28, 29 a left-bank of John Day River. I placed flag on opposite bank and on line. and then run E 58 links for base and find flag bears N 43° 1/2 W. which makes for distance across river 1.27 ch which added to 20.00 makes to right-bank of river

placed temp cor

I then run West from temp cor bearing 190° E on Random line

and find 1/4 sec cor on N line of 20 in good condition

I then established at temp cor a stone 13 x 17 x 19 set six ins in ground and marked G.S. 20 for County surveyor and Center of sec 20.

I then run West from Commencing cor (the west-line of sec 20 being through thick brush and swamp and difficult to project)

to Cottonwood pole driven in swamp on section line West of sec 20. believing the original stone cor to be sunk in swamp I established sec cor (see page 17 Book B Bearing Trees)
