Prarie Lode

Commencing at white quartz stone  $7 \times 9 \times 18$  ins  
marked M M (for mineral monument - 1801), in mound  
of stone and running on magnetic course  $S 14^\circ E$   
300 feet - placed stone marked M M in the ground and  
resting over glass bottles buried <sup>2</sup> 18 inches deep in centre  
of road running N V V<sup>2nd</sup> and SE thence E on left-angle  $90^\circ$   
750 feet - placed stone  $8 \times 12 \times 24$  marked M M in stone  
mound thence on same course 750 feet - placed <sup>3</sup> stone  $8 \times 7 \times 14$   
inches marked M M in stone mound. Thence angle left-  
 $90^\circ$  and run <sup>4</sup> 300 feet - placed stone  $5 \times 11 \times 15$  in stone  
mound marked M M. Thence same course 175 feet - and  
placed stone  $5 \times 12 \times 15$  ins marked M M in stone mound  
thence on left-angle  $90^\circ$  750 feet - and placed  
stone  $6 \times 15 \times 19$  in stone mound marked M M. Thence  
same course 750 feet - to stone  $6 \times 15 \times 17$  in stone  
mound thence angle left- $90^\circ$  175 feet - to place of  
beginning

Fellows Quartz Mining Claim

Commencing at stone marker M M (mineral  
monument - 1801) being N E corner of Prarie Lode  
Quartz claim and running on magnetic course  $N 14^\circ$   
West - 175 feet - to stone marked M M in stone mound  
and being in dimensions  $7 \times 10 \times 19$  ins thence on  
same course 300 feet and placed stone  $6 \times 13 \times 14$   
ins marked M M in stone mound. Thence  
left-angle <sup>4</sup>  $90^\circ$  750 feet - placed stone  $6 \times 13 \times 20$  ins  
marked M M in stone mound. Thence on same
