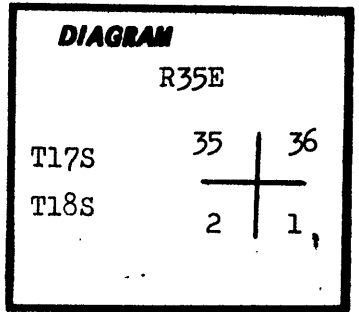


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Established in 1883 by Henry W. Cooke under contract no. 488, dated August 11, 1883. Surveyor General's records state:

Set a basalt stone 16x12x6 ins 10 ins in ground for cor to Secs 1, 2, 35 and 36 marked with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges, and raised a mound of stone 3/2 ft high 5 ft base alongside



Description of corner evidence found:

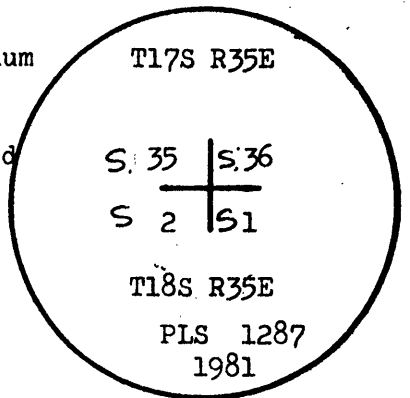
At the assumed corner location I found a 18x16x8 stone with 5 notches on the W face and 1 notch on the E face, in a large mound of stone. A location tag marked HDM and WBM, 4/11/31 is on a fence post just west of mound.

A 31" pine snag scribed T17S R35E, S 35 BT bears N. 19° W. 159.2 ft. This BT is not of record, but appears to have been the same age as of the original GLO notes say.

A 12" pine with N-S blazes lies SW of corner.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the location of the marked rock I set a standard USFS all aluminum monument consisting of a 3" disk mounted on a 2 1/2x30" pipe with a flared base, buried 18 inches in the ground and surrounded by a mound of stone 4 ft diameter by 12 inches high. The original marked corner stone is buried alongside the monument. Disk is stamped as shown. Set on June 2, 1982 and witnessed by Pedro Zabala and Steve Moss.



New BT's established.

- a 12" P. Pine bears N. 25°45' E., 30.9 ft distant, scribed T17S R35E, S 36 BT
- a 12" P. pine bears S. 58°25' E., 49.0 ft distant, scribed T18S, R35E, S. 1, BT
- a 12" P. Pine bears S. 19°30' W., 33.6 ft distant, scribed T18S, R35E, S 2, BT

All BT's are banded with red paint, carry BT and Attention signs, and have brass disks stamped PLS 1287, nailed at the base of the BT blaze
