

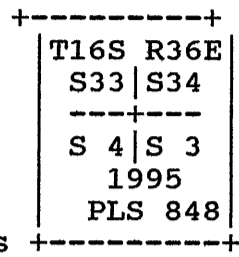
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Henry W. Cook, in 1881, under GLO Contract No. 422. Surveyor General Field Notes State:

Set a basalt stone 18x14x5 ins 12 ins in the ground for cor to secs 3,4,33,&34 Marked with 3 notches on E&W edges from which: a pine 24 ins diam. bears N88°E 85 lks dist marked T16S R36E S34 BT. a pine 6 ins diam bears S45°E 61 lks dist marked T17S R36E S3 BT. a pine 48 ins diam bears N28°W 76 lks dist marked T16S R36E S33 BT.

Description of Corner Evidence Found:

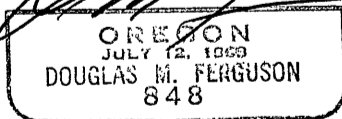
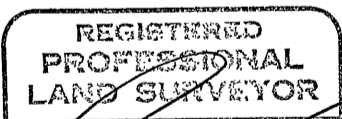
Found a 16"x10"x4" stone, with 3 notches on the east and west edges, set 1' north of a mound of stone. A fire in the area has destroyed remains of bearing trees.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the original stone, Set a 2-1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with 3-1/4" aluminum cap, stamped as shown in DIAGRAM, 25" in the ground. Buried original stone north alongside monument and rebuilt mound of stone around monument. From which:

Set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with plastic caps stamped PLS 848 at the following bearings and distances:
 N52°45'W, 24.7 ft., no marks
 N53°15'E, 30.3 ft., one groove in top of pin.
 S52°45'E, 27.2 ft., two grooves in top of pin.
 S53°15'W, 31.8 ft., three grooves in top of pin.

Measurements to accessories taken with a magnetic compass, declination 17°east, and a nylon clad steel tape. Set steel fence post with Land Survey Monument sign 5'north.
