

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

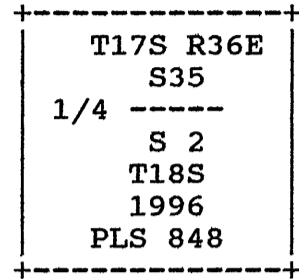
History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by John W. Meldrum under joint contract with David P. Thompson in 1874.

Surveyor General Field Notes state:

Set a basalt stone 20x9x8 for 1/4 corner.

Description of Corner Evidence Found:

Found original stone 20"x18"x10" with 1/4 marked clearly chiseled near top face. Accepted as corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of original stone.

Set 2-1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with 3-1/4" aluminum cap, stamped as shown in DIAGRAM, 12" in the ground and raised a mound of stone 1 1/2' high x 2 1/2' dia. Placed original stone in mound to the north alongside pipe.

From which:

Set 5/8"x30" iron pins with plastic caps stamped PLS 848 at the following bearings and distances.

N34°W, 20.9 ft., no marks.

N34°15'E, 30.3 ft., one groove in top of pin.

A Juniper 8" dia. bears S21°45'E, 168.5 ft., scribed: 1/4 S2 BT.

A Juniper 6" dia. bears S17°30'W, 89.4 ft., scribed: 1/4 S2 BT.

Measurements to accessories taken with a magnetic compass, declination 17° east, and a nylon clad steel tape. Set steel fence post with Land Survey Monument sign 5' north. Nailed a brass washer stamped PLS 848 on blaze above BT scribe as taken this survey. Nailed Bearing Tree signs above blaze and Land Survey Monument signs on back of each tree as required. Painted a 6" red band above Bearing Tree signs and painted blaze red.
