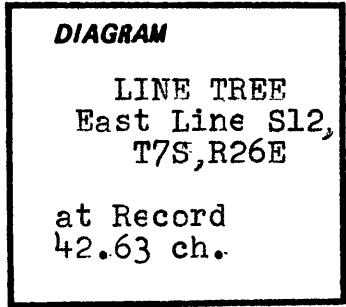


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This monument was originally established by Aaron F. York under G.L.O. Contract number 309 dated November 18, 1878. Running North on the E. boundry of S12, T.7S., R.26E. at 42.63 ch. he called A Pine 40<sup>th</sup>.



Description of corner evidence found:

I found a cut Pine stump, approximately 24" dia. with the tree alongside with double hacks visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I painted 6<sup>th</sup> red stripes on the stump and tree and put BT tags and "Attention<sup>th</sup>" signs on both. I did not mark BTs at this angle point as this point is well referenced by the nearby E $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of S12. Said corner bears S0<sup>o</sup> 45' 53"W a distance of 174.25 ft..
