History of original corner establishment: (continued)

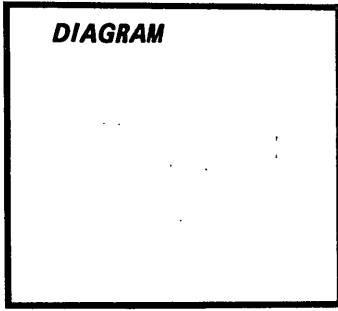
Set a 30 in. x 2½ in. iron pipe with 3 in. brass cap marked as shown, 25 in. in the ground for the corner to Secs. 31, 32, 5 & 6, from which new BT's

A Fir 36 in. diam. bears N17°W, 19.4 ft. dist. marked T6S, R31E, S31 BT.

A Fir 9 in. diam. bears S40°E, 44.9 ft. dist. marked T7S R31E, S5 BT.

Distances taken to a brass washer in the blaze of each tree.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with declination = 20°E.
