

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Index: V-19

Quarter corner Sec. 26 and 35, T.7S., R.31E., W.M.
 Original corner was set by Frank Campbell under
 Contract Number 380 in 1881.
 His record reads:
 Set a pine post for 1/4 Sec. cor. from which a
 Pine 30 in. in dia. bears N69°E, 67 lks. dist.
 Pine 30 in. in dia. bears S52°W, 43 lks. dist.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found the original BT's :
 Scalped ground and found discolored brown area where post penetrated
 ground at approximate corner location from which:
 A Ponderosa Pine stump bears S52°W, 29.7' to center with 1/4S and BT
 scribe well preserved in pitch.
 A Ponderosa Pine stump bears N69°E, 48.4' to center with face removed by
 logging. The corner lies about 3' South of the center of a spring area.

Description of corner monument and accessories I established to
 perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the point of the discolored earth, I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum
 monument with 2 1/2" aluminum cap 26" in the ground with a collar of
 stone within 2" of the top. The cap is stamped as shown in the diagram.
 The bearings were based on the record bearings of the existing witness
 trees.

I set the following new witness trees:

A 13" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears S61 3/4°W, 32.5' scribed 1/4 S35 BT.
 A 17" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears S21°E, 13.1' scribed 1/4 S35 BT.
 A 14" dbh Douglas Fir bears N54 1/2°W, 55.3' scribed 1/4 S26 BT.
 A 15" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N26 1/4°E, 48.0' scribed 1/4 S26 BT.
 An aluminum washer stamped RLS852 is nailed between the letters B and T
 on each new tree. All the BT's have LSM and BT signs attached.
 Painted 6" red bands around all the trees and painted the
 scribe blazes red.

This work was completed December 28, 1993.
