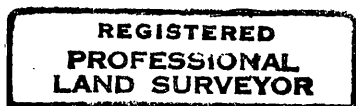
Description of corner evidence found:

Found the corner monument as described from which:
 A 19" dbh Douglas Fir bears S80°E, 30.8' with visible scribe.
 A dead 15" dbh Douglas Fir bears S85°W, 46.3' with visible scribe.

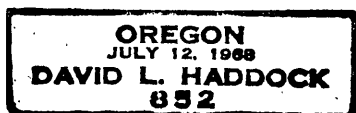
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cleared brush and debris from corner and set new bearing trees as follows:
 A 10" dbh Lodgepole Pine bears N14°E, 47.6' scribed C1/4 S28 BT.
 A 8" dbh Lodgepole Pine bears N35 1/4°W, 39.8' scribed C1/4 S28 BT.
 A 9" dbh Douglas Fir bears S31 1/2°W, 91.9' scribed C1/4 S28 BT.
 The bearings were based on the record bearings to the existing BT's.
 An aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each new tree. All the BT's have LSM and BT signs attached.
 Painted 6" red bands around all the trees and painted the scribe blazes red.
