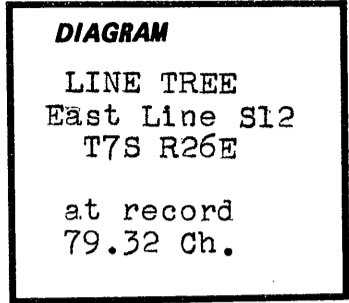


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This monument was originally established by Aaron F. York under G.L.O. contract number 309 dated November 18, 1878. Running North on the E. Line of S12, T.7s., R.26E. at 79.32 Ch. he called a Pine 36".



Description of corner evidence found:

I found a weathered Pine Stump, presently approximately 24" dia.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I painted a 6" red stripe on the stump and attached a BT tag and an "Attention" sign. I did not mark BTs at this angle point as this point is well referenced by the nearby NE Sec. corner of S12. Said corner bears N0° 10' 45" W a distance of 43.25 ft.
