

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

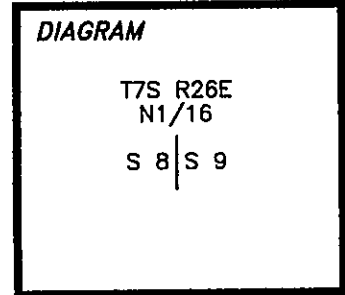

History of original corner establishment:

1979, Wayne O. Harris, Registered Land Surveyor No. 346, while surveying sections 8 and 9 (Grant Co. Survey No. 585) for the Forest Service established this corner as follows:

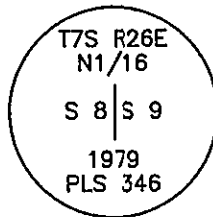
Set 32" X 2" flanged iron pipe with brass cap marked:
White Fir, 7" Dia., BRS. S33 1/2°W, 15.2 Ft. Distance.
White Fir, 12" Dia., BRS. N16 1/2°E, 16.7 Ft. Distance.
6' Iron Fence Post with "Survey Monument" sign within 5' of Corner.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., projecting 16 ins. above ground, surrounded by a mound of earth and stone, 2 ft. base, 6 ins. high, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir snag, 10 ins. diam., 18 ins. high, bears S. 33 1/2° W., 15.2 ft. dist., with scribe B visible on open blaze.

From this corner a steel T bar fence post, with attached LAND SURVEY MONUMENT sign, bears N. 22° E., 3.6 ft. dist.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Marked New BT's

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 15° E., 21.2 ft. dist., mkd. N1/16 S9 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 88° W., 50.2 ft. dist., mkd. N1/16 S8 BT.

Set aluminum U channel post, 6 ft. long, with attached FOREST SERVICE PROPERTY BOUNDARY sign, 3.0 ft., E. of the corner.

The new BT's are double blazed and have a 2 1/2 inch x 1/4 inch magnetic nail (Mag Nail), with a 1 1/2 inch diameter stainless steel washer stamped "OR LS-2308 WA LS-33150" driven at the base on the right side center.
