

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

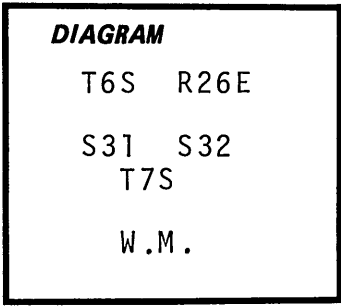
History of original corner establishment:

This corner was established in 1880 by Edward W. Sanderson, under General Land Office Contract No.368

Surveyor General's records state:

Set stone 20 x 13 x 4 in a stone mound for corner, from which

- A Pine 30" dia. bears North 30° West 143 links
- A Pine 24" dia. bears North 32° East 120 links
- A Pine 10" dia. bears South 35° East 160 links



Description of corner evidence found:

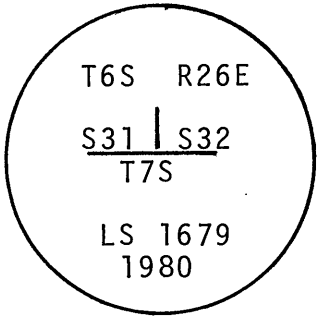
Found a stone of comparable size, but with no discernable marks in a mound of stone from which I found the following original accessories:

- A P. Pine stump 28" dia., with scribe marks "BT" in open blaze bears North 32° East 79.20 feet to face of blaze (record North 32° East 79.2 feet)
- A dead and down P. Pine 28" dia., with scribe marks T6S R26E S31 in open blaze, the roothole of which bears North 3° West 26.2 feet (record North 30° West 94.4 feet)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a 2" x 30" flanged G.I. Pipe with a 2-1/2" Brass Cap exposed 16" in a mound of stone marked:

I take the following bearing trees and take the measurements to the center of the tree at the lower blaze in which I place a brass washer stamped LS 1679



- P. Pine 11" dia. bears North 23-1/4° East 25.5 feet mkd T6S R26E S32 BT
- P. Pine 13" dia. bears South 9-1/2° West 30.3 feet mkd T7S R26E S5 BT
- P. Pine 7" dia. bears North 31-1/2° West 41.1 feet mkd T6S R26E S31 BT

I hereby certify the above corner monument was re-established as herein described on November 6, 1980.
