

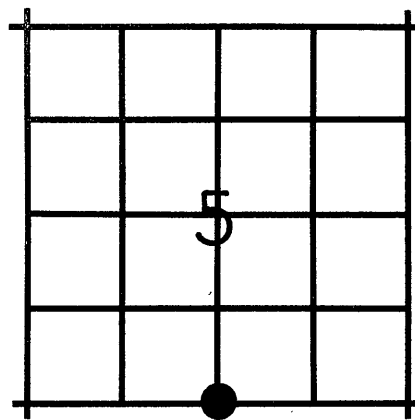

EVIDENCE FOUND:

No evidence of the original corner post was found.
The corner position is established at record bearing and distance from the original bearing tree in section 8.

From the corner point:
A dead and down pine, 30ins. diam., bears S.11°W., 32.3 feet., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ in the remains of a deteriorating blaze.
This BT had fallen years ago blaze down. We had to cut it in two places and roll the blaze over to identify the marks. Judging from the way the tree fell and the position of the blaze, I determined it had to be the BT in sec. 8, there is really no doubt of this.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

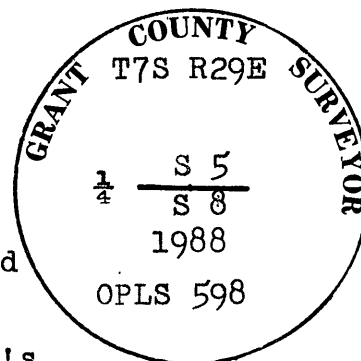
Show how trees are scribed and basis of bearings, including compass var.

At the corner point: Set a $1\frac{1}{2}$ x 30 inch galvanized iron pipe 28 inches in the ground, with brass cap marked as shown, from which I scribe NEW BT's.

MONUMENT MARKED

A Ponderosa Pine, 21 ins. diam., bears N.30°E., 198.2 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S5 CSBT.

A Ponderosa Pine, 23 ins., diam., bears S.27°E., 86.8 feet., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S8 CSBT.



Attached County Surveyor BT tags to BT's and painted blazes with red tree marking paint. Used magnetic compass with 20° E. variation and steel tape, measuring to a 50d nail driven in side center of new BT's at root crown. Set a steel fence post 2 ft. West of corner monument.

I placed several stones around the iron pipe monument .
