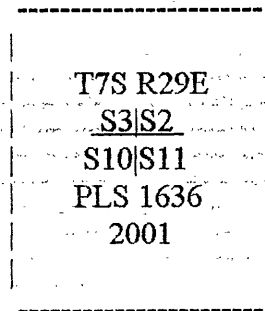


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

DIAGRAM



History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Frank W. Campbell on May 10, 1881, under GLO contract No. 380, as follows:

- Set a post for cor. to sec's 2, 3, 10 & 11, from which a:
- Pine 20" in dia. bears N22° E, 50 links (33.0 feet).
- Pine 20" in dia. bears N12° W, 6 links (3.96 feet).
- Pine 15" in dia. bears S9° E, 5 links (3.3 feet).
- Pine 30" in dia. bears S50° W, 43 links (28.38 feet).

Corner evidence recovered:

- A 20" diameter by 8 foot high broken Ponderosa Pine snag with visible scribes on previously chopped open double blazes bears N22° E, 33.0 feet.
- A shallow root hole is all that remains of the original bearing tree to the southeast.
- A down and decayed Ponderosa Pine with fragmentary scribes visible on a large blaze, root hole bears S50° W, 28.4 feet.
- A well defined root hole, all that remains of the original northwest bearing tree, bears N12° W, 4.0 feet.

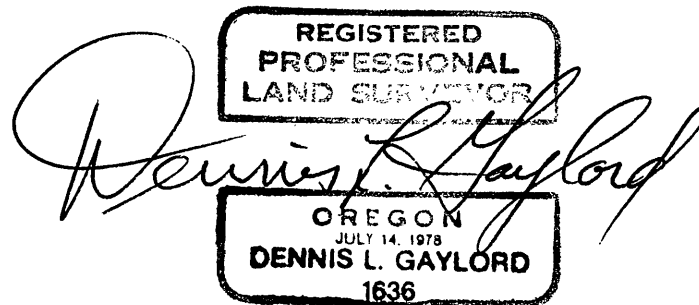
Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

At the point for the corner, as determined by record measurements from the remains of the original bearing trees, I set a 1" x 30" flared, galvanized iron pipe 27" into the ground. I build a small mound of stones around the pipe. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above, from which:

- A 16" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T7S R29E S2 BT", bears N58° E, 97.1 feet.
- A 17" Western Juniper, scribed "T7S R29E S11 BT", bears S89° 30' E, 23.1 feet.
- A 7" Western Juniper, scribed "T7S R29E S10 BT", bears S19° W, 49.0 feet.
- A 24" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T7S R29E S3 BT", bears N76° W, 45.7 feet.

The new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the bottom of the lower blaze.

I hereby certify the above corner was perpetuated as hereon described on July 24, 2001. Magnetic declination set in compass: 18° E.
