

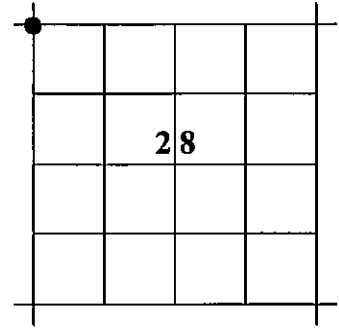
CORNER RESTORATION

CORNER: NW Cor. Sec. 28 Twp. 7 S. Range 29 E., W.M.

ORIGINAL SURVEY BY: Frank W. Campbell

SURVEY NUMBER: 380

CONTRACT DATE: March 19, 1881



ORIGINAL G.L.O. DESCRIPTION: Set a basalt stone 18x10x8 in a mound of stone for cor. to Secs. 20, 21, 28, 29.

EVIDENCE FOUND: Found a basalt stone measuring 18"x9"x8", marked with 3 notches along one edge with no other marks identifiable. The stone was lying in a 3 foot mound of stone in a north-south fence line. We also found a juniper with an old Heppner Lumber Company K-tag attached, which is South 22 feet from found corner. The tag is marked *CORNER: .34 CH.* with the initials *ALP* and dated 5-8-53.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

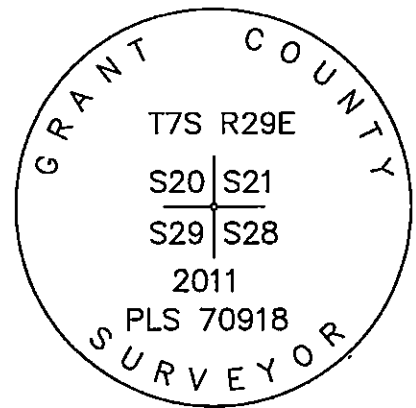
At the corner point: I set a 1½"x24" galv. iron pipe, 10" in the ground, with attached Grant County Surveyor brass cap, marked as shown below. Placed marked stone east and alongside iron pipe, and built a 3 foot mound of stone.

FROM THE CORNER POINT I SET NEW REFERENCE POINTS:

- ▶ A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.47°35'E., 42.69 ft. with attached aluminum cap marked GRANT COUNTY SURVEYOR RP1 2011.
- ▶ A 5/8"x15" iron pin bears S.37°56'W., 24.88 ft. with attached aluminum cap marked GRANT COUNTY SURVEYOR RP2 2011.

I ALSO SCRIBED NEW BEARING TREES:

- ▶ An 8" DBH juniper bears N.86°39'W., 44.30 ft., marked S20 CSBT.
- ▶ A 16" diameter juniper (measured at center of blaze) bears N.30°53'E., 81.29 ft., marked T7S R29E S21 CSBT.



Used RTK GPS to measure RP's and bearings to the trees. Used a steel tape to measure distances to the trees, measuring to a 50d nail driven in the side-center at the root crown of the trees. Attached a BT tag to each tree. Bearings are based on geodetic North from a GPS observation taken at the section corner.
