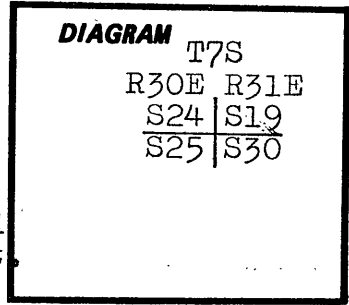


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner first established by Henry Meldrum in 1881, under contract No. 380, dated March 19, 1881. Set a basalt stone 15" X 8" X 8" in a mound of stone. A Pine 18" dia. bears N.22°E., 109 lks. In 1974 Leland Myers remonumented the Corner setting a 2½" brass cap on a 2" X 30" galvanized pipe. Raised a rock mound 6" high and 30" diameter around monument. B.T's..
16" P. Pine N.54°W. 24.3' scribed T7SR31ES30BT.
10" P. Pine N.54°E. 15.1' scribed T7SR30ES25BT.
16" P. Pine S.12°E. 17.5' scribed T7SR30ES24BT.
In each lower blaze set a brass washer stamped RLS 699.

Description of corner evidence found:

2½" diam. brass cap in a 2" iron pipe extending 2"± above a rock mound and 1' West of a N-S fence. Cap mkd. per sketch.
12" D.B.H. (10") Ponderosa Pine, S.54°W., 15.1', scribed T7SR30ES25BT. Brass washer in lower blaze.
19" D.B.H. (16") Ponderosa Pine, N.12°W., 17.5', scribed T7SR30ES24BT. Brass washer in lower blaze.
26" D.B.H. (18") Ponderosa Pine, N.22°E., 72.7', (109 lks.) with scribes on an opened face.
S.E. B.T. with full scribes, dead and down.
Note: The bearings by Myers are reversed, everything else is OK.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

6" D.B.H. Douglas Fir, S.46°E., 18.8', scribed T7SR31ES30BT. Set a brass washer mkd. RPLS 1910 between B&T. Set B.T. tag, attn. sign, painted bands and faces red. Also painted bands and faces red on other B.T's.. Distances are measured to center of tree 1' above the root crown. Bearings are Magnetic North, 20° East declination.
