

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Index: V-17

Corner Sec. 26, 27, 34 & 35, T.7S., R.31E., W.M.

Original corner was set by Frank Campbell under Contract Number 380 in 1881.

His record reads:

Set a pine post for corner to Sec's. 26 & 27-34 & 35 from which a

A pine 10 ins. diam. bears S74°W, 89 lks. dist.

A pine 10" ins. diam. bears N9°W, 89 lks. dist.

A pine 10" ins. diam. bears N63°E, 112 lks. dist.

A pine 30" ins. diam. bears S66°30'E, 162 lks. dist.

In 1974 OPLS 699 remonumented this corner from 4

living BT's. His record reads:

Established the corner location using the BT info of above and set 2"x18" galvanized pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap 16" in ground to bedrock and anchored with 12" of concrete 8" in diameter. Surrounded monument with rock mound 4" high and 30" in diameter. Set two 4"x4"x6' redwood posts with signs as guard posts. Painted red bands on the BT's and posted signs 54-3.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found the iron pipe with brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram.

From which:

A 29" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears S74°W, 60.0' with healed blaze. A 37" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N9°W, 60.0' with healed blaze. A 23 " dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N 63°E, 74.3' with healed blaze. A 30' high 35" dbh Ponderosa snag bears S66°E, 108.7' with visible scribe.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

The bearings were based on the record bearings of the existing witness trees.

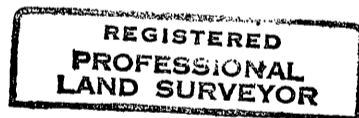
I set the following new witness trees:

A 10" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears S73 1/2°E, 67.2' scribed T7SR31ES35BT.

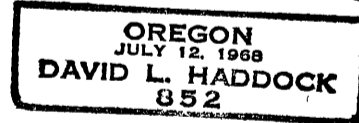
An aluminum washer stamped RLS 852 is nailed between the letters B and T on the new tree. All the BT's have LSM and BT signs attached.

Painted 6" red bands around all the trees and painted the scribe blazes red.

This work was completed December 28, 1992.
