Description of corner evidence found.
 Louisiana Pacific cruiser's tag on line 40 feet west.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:
 The bearings were measured with a staff compass with a N20°E declination. I set a 2 1/2" x 30 " aluminum monument with 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 26" in the ground with a collar of stone to 2" from the top.
 I set the following witness trees:
 A 13" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N74 1/2°E, 35.9' scribed E 1/16 S26 BT.
 A 17" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears S14 1/4°W, 36.1' scribed E 1/16 S35 BT.

An aluminum washer stamped RLS852 is nailed between the letters B and T on each new tree. All the BT's have LSM and BT signs attached. Painted 6" red bands around all the trees and painted the scribe blazes red.

This work was completed December 28, 1993.
