

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Index: Z-19

Quarter corner Sec. 35, T.7S., and Sec. 2, T.8S.,
of R.31E., W.M.

Original corner was set by Frank Campbell under
Contract Number 380 in 1881.

His record reads:

Set a basalt stone 18x18x15, raised mound stone for
1/4 sec. cor. from which:

A Y. pine, 20 in. dia., bears S23°E, 55 lks. dist.

In 1974 OPLS 699 remonumented this corner. His record
reads: Found a stone mound but did not find any chisell

marks. The original BT is down and the blazing and scribing are up.
Dead and down Pine S23°E 36.3'.

Set 2"x30" galvanized pipe with flared end and 2 1/2" brass cap 18" in
Set a 4"x4"x6" redwood post 16" in the ground and surrounded by a mound
of rock 4" West of monument. Set and scribed new BT's

10" Juniper S20°E 39.0' 1/4 S2 in upper blaze and BT in lower blaze.

20" P. Pine N50°E 57.5' 1/4S35 in upper blaze and BT in lower blaze.

Brass washer stamped RLS 699 nailed in lower blaze.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found the iron pipe with brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram.

From which:

A dead and down Ponderosa Pine log bears S23°E, 36.3' with visible scribe.

A 11" dbh Juniper bears S20°E, 39.0' with visible scribe.

A 20" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N50°E, 57.5' with visible scribe.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the
original location of this corner:

The bearings were based on the record bearings of the existing witness
trees.

I set the following new witness trees:

A 13" dbh Ponderosa Pine bears N68 1/2°W, 71.0' scribed 1/4S35BT.

A 9" dbh Juniper bears S75 3/4°W, 109.2' scribed 1/4S2BT.

An aluminum washer stamped RLS852 is nailed between the letters B and T
on each new tree. All the BT's have LSM and BT signs attached.

Painted 6" red bands around all the trees and painted the
scribe blazes red.

This work was completed December 28, 1993.
