

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

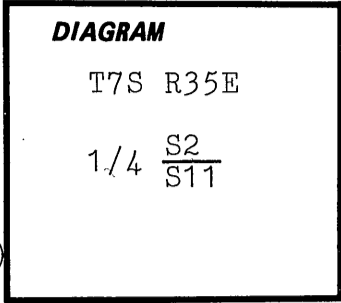
Corner established by Herman D. Gradon, under contract No. 499 dated March, 1884.

The original notes state that at the corner:

A 3 in. square by 3 ft. marked post was set 24 in. in the ground for the 1/4 corner, from which:

A 10 in. dia. Pine bears N9°W - 46 lks (30.4 ft.) marked: 1/4 S BT

A 6 in. dia. Tamarack bears S12°W - 27 lks (17.8 ft.), marked: 1/4 S BT



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in County records.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 1 1/2 in. dia. Tamarack bears S12°W - 27 lks (17.8 ft.). We opened the blaze to reveal visible scribing.

A faint depression of an old stump hole was found where the called for Pine BT fell.

This corner was re-established by bearing-distance from the found bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set: A 2 1/2 in. by 30 in. aluminum pipe, with a 2 1/2 in. aluminum cap, 25 in. in the ground with a mound of earth to the cap, from which:

- A 12 in. dia. Tamarack bears S16°E - 31.0 ft., scribed: 1/4 S11 BT BT
- A 19 1/2 in. dia. Tamarack bears N67°E - 41.8 ft., scribed 1/4 S2 BT BT (double blaze)

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of the lower blaze, and has 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached. The face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around each bearing tree are painted red.

Set a steel fence post, with 54-4 sign attached, East of the monument.

Used a steel tape and a magnetic staff compass, with 20° East declination. Measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was monumented on September 1, 1983.

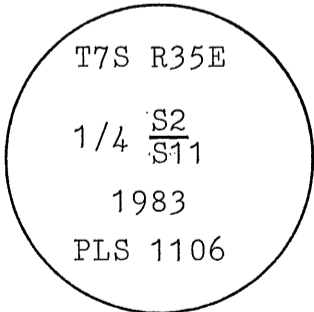
