

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

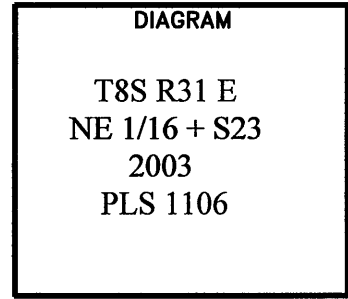
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by William R Wells, in Grant County Map of Survey No. 599. Notes state: At corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap, was set 27 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Established 2 new BT's:

A 14" Tamarack bears S71 1/2°W 12.8 feet scribed NE 1/16 S23 BT.

A 12" Tamarack bears S66°E 14.0 fet scribed NE 1/16 S23 BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe with 3" brass cap projecting 2" from earth and stone mound. This monument, established for the corner on Map of Survey No. 599, in 1979, was rejected due to new evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I establish the corner point by survey and set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, with 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in Diagram, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth. Set steel fence posts South and East of corner and attached sign 54-9 and 54-2 to one post and sign 54-2 to the other post. I change the rejected 1979 monument to a reference monument. The reference monument bears South 82°43' West, 45.9 feet from the new corner monument and is marked: "RM, T8S R31E, 45.9 FT → ,2003, PLS 1106".

From the new corner point:

A 15" standing, dead western larch with scribing visible on open double blaze bears S 83 1/2° W, 58.7 feet. (1979 BT).

A 12" western larch with dead top and scribing visible on partly healed double blaze bears S 74 1/2° W, 35.0 feet, (1979 BT), blaze faces NW.

A 6" Ponderosa pine bears N 32 1/2° E, 7.3 feet, scribed NE 1/16 S23 BT. (New BT).

New bearing tree has a 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to face of blaze.

Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree.

This corner was monumented on May 06, 2003. Used magnetic compass with 18° East declination and measured to accessories with steel tape. Measurements to bearing trees are to the center of the tree.
