

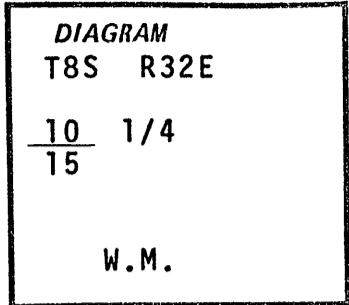
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was established in 1884 by Herman D. Gradon, under General Land Office Contract No. 499.

Surveyor General's Records state:

Set a 3"x3"x3' post 24" in ground.
A Black Pine 8" dia. bears N29°E 9 lks.
A Black Pine 8" dia. bears S64°W 8 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

None

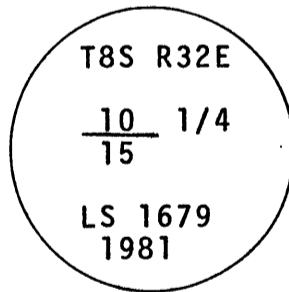
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a 2"x30" flanged G.I. pipe with 2-1/2" brass cap exposed 11".

I mark the following trees with a washer (LS 1679) in the lower blaze:

- L. Pine 8" dia. bears N62°00'W 15.4 feet.
- L. Pine 8" dia. bears S03°04'W 38.0 feet.
