

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

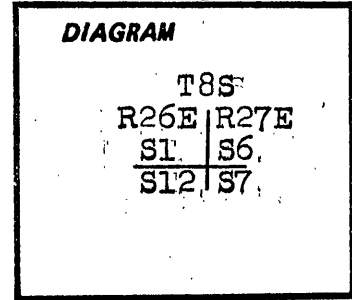

History of original corner establishment:

Alonzo Gesner, under G.L.O. contract number 266, dated June 20, 1877, set a stone 20"X 14"X 5" from which:

- A Yellow Pine, 22" dia., N. W., 200 lks.
- A Yellow Pine, 12" dia., S. W., 78 lks.
- A Yellow Pine, 16" dia., S. E., 54 lks.



Note: Only the quadrants appear in the field notes.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a stone 18"X 15"X 5" marked: $\frac{8}{26}$; with a small stone mound on the west side.

From the corner:

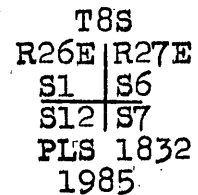
A burned, uprooted and rotted stump with fragmentary scribing on burned blaze: the root hole bears S47°E, 35 ft.

- A Ponderosa Pine, 16" dia., S42½°W, 49.1 ft. with scribing visible.
- A Ponderosa Pine, 33" dia., N52½°W, 130.4 ft. with a healed blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the original corner point I set a 2½"X 30" alum. pipe with a 3" alum. cap containing a magnet and marked:

I buried the original stone alongside and built a stone mound around the monument.



From the corner:

- A Juniper, 9" dia., N69°E, 29.4 ft.; marked: T8S R27E S6 BT
- A Ponderosa Pine, 17" dia., S33¼°E, 51.9 ft.; marked: T8S R27E S7 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" stripe painted red, a BT tag and an "Attention" sign. New BTs have, additionally, an alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with an "Attention" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 19¼°E.
