

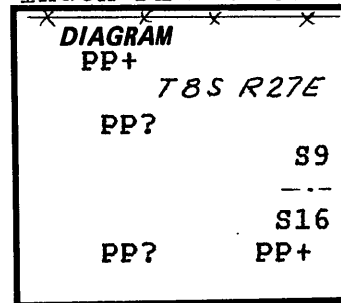
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. J-11

History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Aaron York under G.L.O. contract 309, dated July 12, 1879. His record reads:

Set Stone 18x12x6 for 1/4 Sec. Cor.
Raised Stone Mound at Cor.



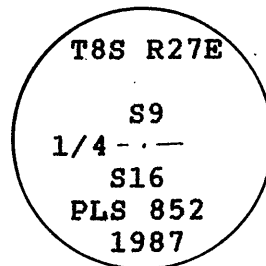
set BT +, record BT x
PP=Ponderosa Pine
J =Juniper
DF=Douglas Fir

?=non-record BT

Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone mound 2' north and 13' east of proportioned 1/4 corner point. Two bearing trees, not of record, nearby with scribing apparently cut by pocket knife, appear to be of the same age as the bearing trees at the 1/4 corner between sections 16 and 21. Other surveyor's have reported finding similar unrecorded bearing trees in the area surveyed by York. There was no stone of record size in the mound of stone. Accepted stone mound as corner. The bearing trees found are as follows:
A 25" Ponderosa Pine bears N72°38'W, 34.4', with a scribe which apparently reads IS9T. A 26" Ponderosa Pine snag bears S76°36'W, 30.4', with a scribe which apparently reads FS9E.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2" I.D. galvanized iron pipe 30" long with 2 1/2" brass cap stamped:
Set pipe 16" into the ground.



Placed a 3' diameter mound of stone around the monument and set a steel fence post 5' east of the monument with Forest Service Land Survey Monument and Property Boundary signs attached. Scribed 1/4 S9 BT on a 11" Ponderosa Pine which bears N55°39'W, 40.8'. Scribed 1/4 S16 BT on a 10" Ponderosa Pine which bears S1°22'W, 8.5'. The bearings are true. Each scribe is in a 30" blaze. Nailed an aluminum washer, stamped RLS 852, between the letters B and T on each tree. Painted a 6" red band around the new bearing trees and attached Forest Service Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.

I certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 14, 1987.
