

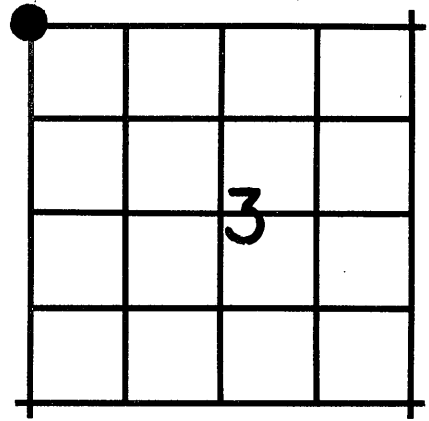

**EVIDENCE FOUND:**

Found stone 10x8x6 firmly set, marked 2 notches on east edge and 3 notches on the west edge. From which: a pine snag, 22" dia., 7 ft. tall, bears N.83°E. 31.0 to face of BT blaze, marked T7SR29E S34 BT. Also found a ½" I.D.x30" galv. iron pipe driven 18" in the ground, south and alongside original corner stone.

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:**

Show how trees are scribed and basis of bearings, including compass var.

At the corner point: I set a 1½"x30" galv. iron pipe, 28" in the ground, with attached Grant County Surveyor Brass Cap marked as shown.

**MONUMENT MARKED**

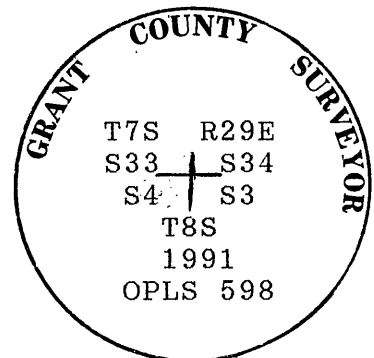
From which I SCRIBE NEW BEARING TREES:

A Juniper 8"diam., bears N58°E, 20.6 ft. marked T7SR29E S34 CSBT.

A Juniper 14"diam., bears S62°E, 20.4 ft. marked T8SR29E S3 CSBT.

The NE trunk of a school marmred Juniper 12"diam., bears S61°W, 39.6 ft. marked T8SR29E S4 CSBT.

A Juniper 8 "diam., bears N44°W, 35.6 ft. marked T7SR29E S33 CSBT.



Buried original marked corner stone south and alongside iron pipe, also drove the ½" iron pipe 8" below ground level, SW 0.25 ft. from GCS iron pipe, surrounded monument with a ring of stones. Used mag. compass with 20°E var. and a steel tape, measuring to a 50d nail driven in the sidecenter, at the root crown of the BT's. Painted BT blazes with red timber marking paint and attached Grant County Surveyor BT tags to BTs'.
