

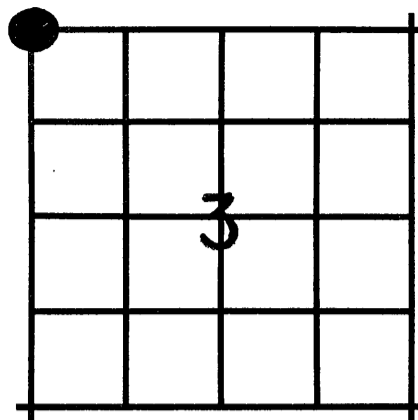

Set a basalt stone 12x12x6 in mound of stone for corner to Sections 3, 4, 33 and 34, from which,

A Juniper 9 in. diam. bears N. 36° E., 61 lks.

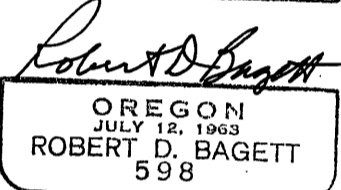
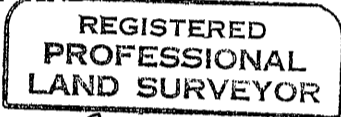

EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found original corner stone, a basalt stone, 16x12x7 inches, marked with 3 notches, rolled down hill 5 ft. ±.

I establish this corner at record bearing and distance from original BT. From corner point:
 Original BT:

A dead & down, burned Juniper 9 ins. diam. bears N. 36° E., 40.3 feet. Faint scribing visible in weathered blaze.

Used true solar bearings, measured from root hole.

**DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:
 Show how trees are scribed and basis of bearings, including compass var.**

At the corner point: I star drilled a 3/4" hole 3" deep into bedrock and set a 3/4"x3" brass stem with 3" brass disc attached into the hole. I then grouted the stem to the bedrock and marked disc as shown.
 From which I scribe NEW BT's:

- A Juniper 13 ins. diam. bears N. 4° E., 15.5 ft. marked T7SR30ES34 CSBT
- A Juniper 4 ins. diam. bears S. 25° W., 12.2 ft. marked X CSBT
- A triple trunked Juniper, scribed middle trunk, 15 inch diam. bears N. 85° W., 63.3 ft. marked T7S R30E S33 CSBT.

I placed original corner stone in a mound of stone West and alongside brass disc.

I attached Grant County Surveyor BT tags and painted 6 inch red band around BTs and on blazes with red tree marking paint. Used mag. compass with 20° E. var. and steel tape measuring to a 50d nail driven in the side center at the root crown of new BT's. Nailed brass washer marked "OPLS 598" to lower blaze.
