

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

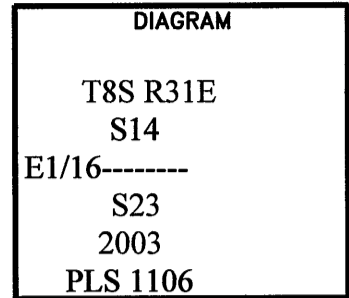
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by William R. Wells, in Grant County Map of Survey No. 599. Notes state: At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with a brass cap, was set 27 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Established 2 new BT's:

A 17" Pine bears N 26 1/2° W 61.7 feet scribed E 1/16 S14 BT.

A 18" Fir bears S14°W 138.0 feet scribed E 1/16 S23 BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe with 3" brass cap projecting 2" from a mound of stones. This monument, established for the corner on Map of Survey No. 599, in 1979, was rejected due to new evidence found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I establish the corner point by survey and set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in Diagram, 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stones. I change the rejected 1979 monument to a reference monument. The reference monument bears South 83°07' West, 61.0 feet from new corner monument and is marked: "RM, T8S R31E, 61.0 FT →, 2003, PLS 1106".

From the new corner point:

A 27" white fir with healed double blaze bears S 35 1/2° W, 166.3 feet. (1979 BT).

A 23" Ponderosa pine with partly healed double blaze bears N 61 1/2° W, 105.5 feet. (1979 BT).

Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree.

Set steel fence post 4 feet South of new corner monument, with signs 54-2 and 54-9 attached.

This corner was monumented on May 6, 2003. Used magnetic compass with 18° East declination and measured to accessories with a steel tape. Measurements to bearing trees are to the center of tree.
