

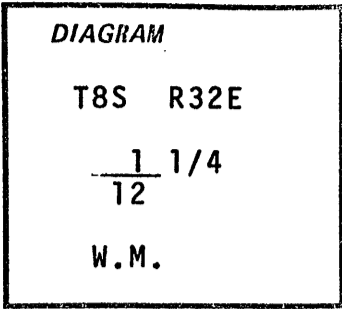
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was established in 1884 by Herman D. Gradon, under General Land Office contract No. 499.

Surveyor General's Records state:

Set a 3"x3"x3' post 24" in the ground.  
A Pine 8" dia. bears N22°E 31 lks.  
A Tamarack 10" dia. bears S49°E 21 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

None

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a 2"x30" flanged G.I. pipe with 2-1/2" brass cap exposed 6" in mound of stone.

I mark the following trees with a washer (LS 1679) in the lower blaze:

D. Fir 10" dia. bears N37°53'W 51.4 feet.  
P. Pine 10" dia. bears S27°39'W 37.2 feet.
