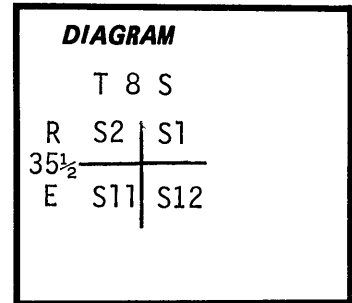


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original survey by W. B. Barr under contract No. 492 dated August 1883.
Set Basalt stone 14x12x10 ins. 10 ins in ground for cor to Secs 1, 2, 11 & 12 marked with 5 notches on S and 1 notch on E. edges from which

- A Fir 10 ins. diam. bears N 50E 48 lks dist marked T8S R 35½ E S1 BT
- A Fir 10 ins diam bears S 65E 36 lks dist marked T8S R35½E S12 BT
- A Fir 6 ins diam bears S 45W 39 lks. dist marked T8S R35½E S 11 BT
- A Spruce 12 ins. diam bears N. 60 W. 30 lks. dist. marked T8S R35½E S2 BT



Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner I found a stone 14"x12"x10", 6" above the ground in good condition with 5 notches on the S. face and 1 notch on the E. face. Also found a 1" x 36" iron pipe set in ground next to rock.

An 18" live spruce with a healed over blaze bears N37° W 19.8 ft.

A down 8" fir bears S 42° E 24.0 ft.
marked T8S R35½E S 12 BT

A stumphole bears S 45° W, 25.7 ft.; a 7" downfir, apparently moved, bears S 61° W, 25.7 ft.
marked T8S R35½E S11 BT

No evidence of N.E. bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I Set a 2½" x 32" brass capped steel pipe 24" in the ground at the original stone position from which:

A 7" fir bears N 31° 30' E 7.46 ft.
marked T8S R35½E S1 BT nail in S base.

A 10" fir bears S 46° E 32.88 ft.
marked T8S R35½E S12 BT nail in E. base.

An 8" fir bears S 77° W 17.07 ft.
marked T8S R35½E S11 BT nail in S. base.

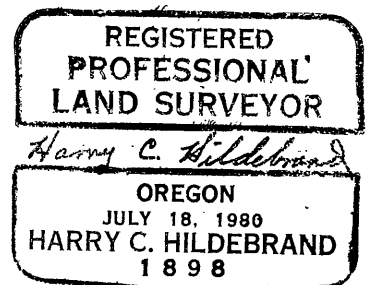
An 8" fir bears N 47° 30' W 22.52 ft.
marked T8S R35½E S2 BT nail in N. base.

Bearings taken with a staff compass declination 18½° East per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nails with brass washers stamped LS 1898 driven into the side center of the bearing trees,
